### Lenten Spiritual Activities

Lent is supposed to look and feel different as we gather for our Sunday and Weekday Masses. The Liturgy makes present to us the mystery of Jesus' 40 days in the desert where he combatted evil. As Jesus himself prayed and fasted, he depended upon God the Father to feed him with love and consolation. We too need the love and the consolation of the Father this Lent. Hopefully our simple liturgies give you the space and the time to meet God in deeper ways. Notice: There are less candles present, the church is decorated with the penitential color of violet, some of the fancier objects have been stored away until Easter, there are less Baptisms being celebrated (although they can be celebrated), we are chanting with less instruments, and we end Mass in silence. Each day the antiphons, prayers and readings are very specific to Lent. Please pay attention to these little details and let the Father show you his love this Lent as we "repent and believe in the Gospel!"

**CEMETERY UPDATE**

The St. Mary Cemetery Committee, which also includes Sacred Heart in Scarborough & St. Amand in Walhain, met on 2/21/19. The committee voted to raise the price of graves to \$400 per burial site. This change will go into effect on April 1, 2019. The increase reflects an appropriate and affordable price when considering the cost of living increases over the years, and that the perpetual care fund requires a significant contribution every time a grave plot is sold.
